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## 2020-2021 School Year Information

Crestwood staff members are excited to see our students! Below you will find helpful information for students who will be in the classroom setting. Please know plans may change, however we will keep you up-to-date as quickly as we can.

### Each Morning Before School

Each morning please ask your child if they have any of the following symptoms: fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, fatigue, muscle and body aches, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell, congestions or runny nose, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.

If your child has any of these symptoms, you will need to wait 14 days from the onset of the symptoms for your child to return to school, unless medical documentation explains these symptoms are due to allergies, etc.

Students with a temperature of 100.4 with no other COVID-19 symptoms, must be fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication in order to return to school.

Students that ride the bus will have their temperature taken when they get on the bus. Any students with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be able to attend school. Please ensure someone is in the house in case your child needs to stay home.

### Drop Off Procedures

Students may be dropped off anytime after 7:50 AM. Each student's temperature will be taken before the parent leaves. Please pull in the circle drive, depending on traffic cars may be routed to the side of the building by the gym. Please follow instruction given by Crestwood staff.

**Students may not be dropped off before 7:50 AM.** Bus riders will enter the building through the junior high doors.

### Start of the School Day

The first bell will ring at 8:10 AM. The first couple of days, students will enter the building and go straight to their classrooms. Younger students will have help finding their classroom and carrying supplies from Crestwood staff and junior high helpers. Breakfast will be grab and go and be eaten in the classroom. Once students understand the procedures they will go outside before school and practice social distancing.

### Face Masks

Face masks are required on the bus, in the hallways, in the restrooms, and in the classrooms. Student will receive breaks from masks when they are outside of the building and practicing social distancing. The school will provide one reusable cloth face mask and a lanyard to ensure each student has a mask at all times. Please make sure you wash your child's face mask frequently. A child who cannot wear a face mask will need to choose remote learning.

**During the School Day**

Students will have scheduled restroom and recess breaks throughout the day. Students will need a water bottle as they will not be allowed to drink out of water fountains. Social distancing will be observed to the greatest extent possible. Please talk with your child about not touching others or other student's personal belongings. Please only bring to school what is absolutely necessary for lunch or educational purposes. Please leave toys at home.

**Dismissal**

Students will be dismissed at 2:50 PM. Regular dismissal procedures will continue this school year. If you are walking to the front door to pick up your child you must wear a mask. Staying in your car in the drive through line is strongly encouraged.

**Lunch**

Students will need to eat school lunch or bring a sack lunch. Visitors will not be allowed in the building to deliver lunch.

**Visitors**

Visitors are not allowed in the building. Please contact your child's teacher via email or phone.

**COVID-19**

If a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19, parents will be notified. The Edgar County Health Department will help with contact tracing. Students and staff who have been in close contact with the student/staff member, meaning within 6 feet of a person who tested positive for COVID-19 for more than 15 minutes, will be contacted. The close contact can happen at school, home or in the community.
