- ◆ The goal of online assessment is to make testing more interactive for students.
- ◆ Students are required to show their work and explain their reasoning so others can understand what they know.
- ◆ Students are asked to read and analyze complex tests and to write well thought out responses.
- ◆ With a greater emphasis on deeper learning, schools are expecting more from students.
- ◆ The tests focus more on applying skills than rote memorization. They capture more information than ever before on how well students think, comprehend, reason and justify an answer.
