**Eagle Expectation:** Encourage Others

**Name of the Setting/ Skill:** Bathroom – Wait Quietly for your Turn

**SEL Standard:** 3B.1b. Make positive choices when interacting with classmates.

### **Purpose of the Lesson:**

1. To allow students in classrooms near the bathroom a quiet environment to learn
2. To maintain safety and order in the bathroom

### **Teaching Examples:**

1. You raise your hand and ask your teacher if you can use the bathroom. Once you are excused you walk quickly to the bathroom. Upon entering the bathroom you see that a line has already formed. Even through it is an emergency, you decide to stand quietly at the back of the line and wait your turn.
2. You are in the bathroom waiting to wash your hands. Some friends in front of you begin singing loudly. You realize that their singing can be heard outside of the bathroom. You know this can disrupt others from learning. You remind your friends that they must be quiet in the bathroom.

### **Kids Activities/Role Play:**

1. Role-play teaching examples #1 and #2.
2. Discuss with students why it is important to wait quietly for your turn in the bathroom.

### **Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:**

1. Compliment students who are quiet in the bathroom.
2. Remind students before entering the bathroom to wait quietly for their turn.
