**Eagle Expectation:** Give Respect

**Name of the Setting/ Skill:** Bathroom – Give Privacy

**SEL Standard:** 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

### **Purpose of the Lesson:**

1. To teacher the privacy demonstrates respect to self and others
2. When we respect others and ourselves we can take pride in ourselves

### **Teaching Examples:**

1. Brad is waiting for a stall in the bathroom. He calls out, “Who’s in there?” When nobody answers he shouts the question again. Jim walks in and says, ‘You need to be quiet and wait.’ Brad was embarrassed but he waited quietly.
2. Steve was using the bathroom stall but the door was not properly shut. It began to open, and the he quickly closed it. Making sure you have privacy shows that you respect yourself.

### **Kids Activities/Role Play:**

1. Discuss ways in which students can show that they respect the privacy of others.
2. Discuss the relationship between privacy and respecting yourself.

### **Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:**

1. Praise students you catch respecting the privacy of others and/or themselves.
2. Remind your class of school expectations before using the bathroom.
