Eagle Expectation: Act Responsibly

Name of the Setting/Skill: Cafeteria - Walk

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain order in the cafeteria
2. To maintain safety in the cafeteria

Teaching Examples:

1. You are happy to be eating with your friends at lunch and are trying to carry your tray to the table. You see your friends and someone else tries to get to the table before you. Then you think, *I need to walk or I might fall and spill my food.* You choose a seat near your friends to eat your lunch.
2. You enter the lunchroom and need to stand in line, but you are very hungry. You want to run to the front of the line to get you food sooner. You stop and think, *If I run to the front of the line, it would not be fair to those already ahead of me. I could also hurt someone or myself.* You choose to wait your turn and walk quietly.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Have students role-play a situation where a student is walking with a tray in the cafeteria.
2. Have students practice walking and waiting in line in the cafeteria.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Reinforce expected behavior with Eagle Eyes.
2. Before lone dismissal, ask a few students to demonstrate safe walking.
