Eagle Expectation: Act Responsibly

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Cafeteria – Deposit Money in Lunch Account

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain an environment that is orderly.
2. To promote responsibility.

Teaching Examples:

1. You receive a notice saying your lunch account is low. You make sure to take the slip home as a reminder to bring money the next day.
2. You bring a check for your lunch account. When the teacher asks if anyone has lunch money, you get your check and take it to the cafeteria because you know it needs to be deposited first thing in the morning.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Discuss how it is the student's responsibility to take the notices home and get the check deposited in the account.
2. Discuss how following this procedure shows respect toward the cafeteria staff.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Compliment students who deposit money in their lunch account first thing in the morning.
