**Eagle Expectation:** Encourage Others

**Name of the Setting/ Skill:** Cafeteria – Stay Seated Until Dismissed

**SEL Standard:** 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

### **Purpose of the Lesson:**

1. To maintain order and flow in the cafeteria
2. To maintain safety in the cafeteria

### **Teaching Examples:**

1. You have just finished eating. You want to get up to throw your garbage away. You begin to do so but realize that you do not have permission to get up. You must wait for an adult to dismiss your table. Even though you are in a hurry, you know that it is important for you to follow the rules.

### **Kids Activities/Role Play:**

1. Have a few volunteers demonstrate sitting quietly until dismissed.
2. Discuss with students why it is important to stay seated until dismissed in the cafeteria.
3. Have students give examples or stories of times they have stayed seated when they wanted to get up.

### **Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:**

1. Compliment students who stay seated until dismissed.
2. Reward students with an Eagle Eye.
