**Eagle Expectation:** Encourage Others

**Name of the Setting/ Skill:** Cafeteria – Form a Single Line

**SEL Standard:** 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

### **Purpose of the Lesson:**

1. Maintaining safety in the cafeteria

### **Teaching Examples:**

1. You are in line to get your food in the cafeteria. You are excited to share a funny story with a friend you see ahead of you in line. You are about to go up to him when you stop and think, “If I stand next to him I might get in someone’s way.” You decide to stay where you are and tell him your story later.

### **Kids Activities/Role Play:**

1. Have a few volunteers role-play forming a single line in the cafeteria.
2. Praise any examples of stories the students offer about why it is important to stay in a single line.

### **Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:**

1. Reinforce expected behavior with an Eagle Eye.
2. Compliment classes who are standing in a single file line.
