Eagle Expectation: Act Responsibly

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Classroom – Have your Materials for Class

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To teach students to have their materials ready for class.
2. To promote an efficient working environment.

Teaching Examples:

1. You are rushing around the house in the morning looking for your shoes. Your mom is yelling to hurry, and you start to just bolt out the door. But, you stop and think, “My homework!” and go back to your room for it.
2. You notice in class that you have only one pencil left in your desk. That night you mention it to your mom and she gets you more. You remember to bring them to school.
3. Your class is going on a field trip and you have to return the permission slip by tomorrow. You remind Mom to sign it, you put it in your folder, and you put your folder in your book bag. You’re set for the field trip!

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Brainstorm ways to remember homework and important notes and projects.
2. Practice filling out assignment notebooks, putting papers into folders, and packing book bags.
3. Discuss consequences of coming to school unprepared.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Reinforce expected behavior with an Eagle Eye.
2. Praise students who come to school with proper materials.
3. Provide incentives to encourage timely return of homework and notes.
