

## Cool Tool

**Eagle Expectation:** Give Respect

**Name of the Setting/ Skill:** Classroom - Listening

**SEL Standard:** 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

### **Purpose of the Lesson:**

1. To maintain an environment that is quiet and orderly
2. To enable students to listen to the teacher or librarian

### **Teaching Examples:**

1. Our class is doing an animal report, and the teacher is explaining how to use the internet to find information. You and your friend are talking about what animal you're going to research when you remember you need to listen. You stop talking and listen to the teacher so you will know where to find the information you need.
2. The librarian is reading a story to your class that you have already heard. You want to talk to your friends about PE that is at the end of the day, but you remember that you should use listen in the library.

### **Kids Activities/Role Play:**

1. Discuss why it is important to listen to directions in the computer lab.
2. Using Teacher Example #2, discuss why it is important to listen and how doing so is a sign of respect.
3. Role-play with a student reading a book while others are in the back talking. Discuss how this is disrespectful.

### **Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:**

1. Praise students who listen in the classroom, computer lab or library.
2. Reinforce expected behavior with an Eagle Eye.
