Eagle Expectation: Give Respect

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Emergencies – No Talking

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain an environment that is safe, quiet, and orderly.
2. To enable students to listen to the safety procedures they need to follow.

Teaching Examples:

1. The school is being evacuating. Your teacher is giving your class instructions on what to do. You want to whisper to your friend and ask what is going on, but you remember that during an emergency you must be silent.
2. The school is having a fire drill. You get in line next your friend, and as you're walking outside you start to talk to her. Then you stop and remember that in emergencies you must be silent.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Discuss reasons why it is important to be silent during emergencies.
2. Role-play being silent during an emergency situation.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Reinforce expected behavior with an Eagle Eye.
2. Praise students who are silent during emergency drills or situations.
