**Eagle Expectation:** Act Responsibly

**Name of the Setting/Skill:** Emergencies – Help others

**SEL Standard:** 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior

### **Purpose of the Lesson:**

1. To maintain safety during an emergency

### **Teaching Examples:**

1. The fire alarm goes off. You get in your lines to evacuate the building. As you leave the building, the person in front of you falls to the ground. You help him/her up and continue outdoors to safety.
2. An emergency arises in the school. Your teacher tells you to line up in order to evacuate the building. One of your classmates has crutches. You decide to hold the door for him/her so they can easily leave the building.

### **Kids Activities/Role Play:**

1. Role-play a situation where someone needs help during an evacuation.
2. Discuss why helping others is the right thing to do.

### **Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:**

1. When you notice a student being helpful to others, reward that student with an Eagle Eye.
2. Compliment students who display helpful behavior.
