

## Cool Tool

**Eagle Expectation:** Act Responsibly

**Name of the Setting/ Skill:** Hallway – Walk on the Right

**SEL Standard:** 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

### **Purpose of the Lesson:**

1. To maintain an environment that is safe, quiet, and orderly
2. To get from one place to another quickly and quietly
3. To be respectful of other classes

### **Teaching Examples:**

1. Your class is waiting in the hall to go to lunch. There are other classes in front of you. It is frustrating, but you know you need to be patient, wait quietly, and keep your hands and feet to yourself and stay to the right.
2. Your class is walking down the hall. Another class is walking towards your class. Walking on the right side of the hall allows both classes to pass quickly.

### **Kids Activities/Role Play:**

1. Practice walking on the right side of the hall.
2. Practice waiting for a class to leave before entering, as well as allowing another class to pass by, while waiting patiently.

### **Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:**

1. Reinforce expected behavior with an Eagle Eye.
2. Praise verbally.
3. Before students walk down the hall, remind them of hallway rules.
