Eagle Expectation: Give Respect

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Hallways – Drink for 3 seconds

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain order at the drinking fountain.

Teaching Examples:

1. Your class has just left the gym. Everyone is hot and thirsty. Your class lines up at the drinking fountain. You are in the front of the line. You are so thirsty that you want to continue drinking of a long time. But then you remember: *There are many people behind me that are just as thirsty as me. I have drank for three seconds and need to allow for others to have a turn.* You stop drinking and allow others to have a turn. *“One, two, three, that’s enough for me.”*

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Practice drinking for three seconds at the drinking fountain and saying, *“One, two, three, that’s enough for me.”*
2. Discuss why it is important to only drink for three seconds.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Give extra praise to students who drink for three seconds.
