Eagle Expectation: Give Respect

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Hallway – Walk in Lines

SEL Standard: 2C.1b Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain an environment that is safe, quiet, and orderly
2. To get from one place to another quickly and quietly
3. To be respectful of other classes

Teaching Examples:

1. Your class is going to Art. Everyone is excited to start their new project and rushes down the hallway. Your teacher makes you stop until everyone is calm and ready to walk correctly.
2. As you are going into the building, someone hits you in the back of the head and runs into their classroom. You start to bolt after them. Then you remember that there are many people going in that same door. You grit your teeth and continue to walk in line.
3. You are taking a test. Another class walks by and someone knocks on your door. You want others to walk by quietly because noise distracts you and interrupts your concentration.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Practice walking down the hall while keeping hands and feet to selves.
2. Role-play teaching example 3. Students work in a quiet environment while the teacher knocks on the door. Then discuss how that affected your concentration.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Praise verbally.
2. Before students walk down the hall, remind them of hallway rules.
