Eagle Expectation: Act Responsibly

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Library/Computer Lab – Bring Materials with you

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain an environment that is orderly.
2. To teach students to be responsible.

Teaching Examples:

1. You are rushing around the house in the morning looking for your shoes. Your mom is yelling to hurry, and you start to just bolt out the door. But, you stop and think, *Today is Library Day*. Before you leave you grab your book off the counter.
2. Today is Library Day. Your class puts library books on the desk to return them to the library. Because you only remembered to bring back one book instead of two, you will only be able to check out one new book. Next time, you will be more prepared and return both books.
3. Your class is working on an animal report. You are going to the computer lab to finish researching your animal. When you're in line in the classroom to leave for the computer lab, you notice everyone has their folders with their animal information in them. You grab your folder out of your desk so you will be prepared for the computer lab.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Discuss the importance of being prepared when going to the Library or Computer Lab.
2. Have students brainstorm on ways to remember when Library Day is and what they need to take to the Computer Lab.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Compliment directly and specifically those students who have all their materials.
2. Before going to the Library or Computer Lab, remind students of what they need and review expectations.
