Eagle Expectation: Act Responsibly

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Playground – Stay in your Assigned Area

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain an environment that is orderly.
2. To provide a safe and secure area for students to play.
3. To enable proper staff supervision.

Teaching Examples:

1. You want to get your ball from your brother, who is on a different area of the playground. You start to run to him as fast as you can. Then you remember that you need to stay in your assigned area on the playground.
2. You walk your little brother to his area of the playground and he and his friends want you to play tag with them. You want to, but you remember that you need to go to your assigned area.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Role-play scenarios in Teaching Example #1 and #2.
2. Discuss why it is important to be in your assigned area on school grounds.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Reinforce expected behavior with an Eagle Eye.
2. Praise students you notice staying in their assigned areas during indoor recess and on school grounds.
