Eagle Expectation: Give Respect

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Playground – Keep hands, feet, and other objects to yourself.

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain safety on school grounds
2. To respect other students and their property

Teaching Examples:

1. You are having fun with your friends at recess. Someone bumps into you, you are angry that they bumped into you and you start to push them. Then you stop and think, *“Maybe that was an accident.”* You tell them in a calm voice, *“Please watch where you are going.”* You continue to play.
2. You are playing kickball and another student says something that makes you miss the ball. You start to pick up the ball to throw it at them, but then you decide to throw it back to the pitcher and try again.
3. When lining up, you notice another student has put their book bag in your “spot.” You want to kick it out of your way, but instead you ask who it belongs to and then ask them to move it.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Role-play teaching examples #1 and #2.
2. Practice lining up using book bags as described in teaching example 3.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Reinforce expected behavior with an Eagle Eye.
2. Praise students for practicing expected behavior.
