Eagle Expectation: Give Respect

Name of the Setting/ Skill: School - Bullying

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To teach students to treat each other with respect and avoid bullying

Teaching Examples:

1. Jennifer thinks that Amy is ignoring her at recess. In anger Jennifer walks up to Amy and grabs her arm and squeezes it. Jennifer then narrows her eyes and glares at Amy. After about 10 seconds, without a work, Jennifer lets go and stomps off. Every time Jennifer is upset with Amy she does this. What should Amy do?
2. Every evening for a week now, Sally has received a text message from Gina. Each message is about the same. Gina calls her names and threatens to physically hurt her. At school, Gina convinces other girls to avoid Sally. What should Sally do?
3. Mike and Steve are in the same class. From home, Mike uses an email account to spread rumors about Steve smoking cigarettes and using drugs. He sends these messages to students in their class and makes the emails appear to come from Steve. Everyone in the class is upset with Steve. What should Steve do?

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Role-play teaching examples 1, 2, and/or 3.
2. Talk to students about sticking up for the person being bullied and tell an adult.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Reward students when they stand up for other students.
2. Make a rule in your classroom to help students who need help.
