Eagle Expectation: Give Respect

Name of the Setting/ Skill: School - Bullying

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To teach students to treat each other with respect and avoid bullying

Teaching Examples:

1. Almost every day, when the teacher isn't looking, Chad reaches over to Billy's desk and pushes a book onto the floor, grabs a pencil, or hits him. He's quick enough that if the teacher hears something, Billy gets reprimanded for disrupting class with noise and Chad isn't caught. What should Billy do?
2. During volleyball, though she tries, Lisa often misses the ball when it comes her way. When this happens, Brittany almost always yells at Lisa, calls her names, or makes a threatening gesture. Though Lisa is intimidated by Brittany, she is tired of this treatment. What should Lisa do?
3. Several students make rude comments about Thomas but Andy is the worst. At recess time, Andy and a few of his friends pretend that Thomas has 'cooties'. They dance around and yell, "Thomas has the cooties." Then they cross their fingers and try to touch him. Thomas doesn't have many friends. He is intimidated by this group of boys but he is also getting very tired of this treatment. What should Thomas do?

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Role-play teaching examples 1, 2, and/or 3.
2. Speak kindly and include the person being bullied.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Reward students when they stand up for other students.
2. Encourage students who are being bullied to tell an adult.
