Eagle Expectation: Give Respect

Name of the Setting/Skill: Assemblies – Sit Quietly

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To be able to listen to the presentation

Teaching Examples:

1. You enter the assembly and sit down with your class. The assembly begins and the person sitting next to you starts whispering in your ear. You can't hear what the presenter is saying. You whisper to your classmate to please be quiet before you both get into trouble.
2. The assembly has begun, and you are really enjoying the presentation. The person in front on you begins stamping their feet. You gently tap them on the shoulder and shake your head no to indicate that they should stop.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Role-play Teaching Examples 1 and/or 2.
2. Discuss the importance of being quiet during an assembly.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Reinforce expected behavior with Eagle Eyes.
2. Remind students of proper behavior before they enter the assembly.
3. Praise verbally.
