Eagle Expectation: Act Responsibly

Name of the Setting/ Skill: Assemblies – Use Bleacher Steps

SEL Standard: 2C.1b. Demonstrate appropriate social and classroom behavior.

Purpose of the Lesson:

1. To maintain an environment that is safe, quiet, and orderly.
2. To promote responsibility.

Teaching Examples:

1. You are going to an assembly and will be sitting on the bleachers. You and your friends are hurrying and start to run up the bleachers. You stop and remind them to use the steps.
2. There is an assembly in the gym and your class is going to sit on the bleachers. It's been raining for 3 days and your shoes are muddy. You remember to use the steps so you won't get dirt on the seats.
3. Your class will be sitting on the bleachers during an assembly. You think it would be faster to go up the bleachers instead of using the steps. You stop and remember to use the steps because that is the safest way to get to your seat.

Kids Activities/Role Play:

1. Discuss how using the steps on the bleachers will help ensure safety, keep the noise level down, and keep the bleachers clean.
2. Practice using the bleacher steps. The teacher should demonstrate how not using the steps could be unsafe.

Follow-up Reinforcement Activities:

1. Compliment student who use the bleacher steps.
2. Pre-correct expected behavior for using bleacher steps appropriately.
